## Advanced TEACCH workshop in Hong Kong

TEACCH stands for 'Treatment and Education of Autistic and related Communication handicapped Children'. The primary aim of TEACCH is to help to prepare people with autism to live or work more effectively at home, at school and in the community.



**Speaker:** Professor Gary Mesibov, former Director of TEACCH and one of the world's leading autism experts.

Dr. Mesibov, Professor Emeritus of psychiatry at the University of North Carolina, led the university's Treatment and Education of Autistic and related Communication-handicapped Children (TEACCH). He was the Director of Division TEACCH in North Carolina for 18 years. Through his 30 years of work with the programme, Dr. Mesibov has helped serve individuals and families affected by autism with innovative diagnostic and supportive services that are now used throughout North Carolina and around the world. He has touched many lives and changed many people's destinies

### Key aims

By the end of this two-day programme, participants will:

- further understand the principles of TEACCH as well as the relationship between the principles and autism
- understand with examples a detailed walk-through of how to develop the work systems
- be exposed to a wide range of work task examples
- understand how, as professionals, we can apply the TEACCH principles to support students' learning in various learning environments and in everyday life
- identify the key features of success and common errors in practice
- see evidence of how TEACCH can promote students' positive behavior and social skills
- understand parental collaboration: parents working with professionals as co-therapists for their children so that the techniques can be applied at home

Participants are expected to have some understanding about TEACCH before coming to the 2 day workshop. Anybody interested in attending the workshop but have no prior knowledge about the TEACCH can attend a free compulsory 2 hour workshop on "An introduction to TEACCH" by Kit Chan (Vice Principal of JCSRS).
